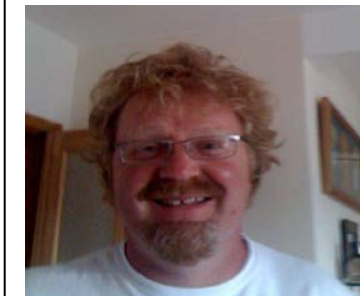




RUSafe?

1: Who am I?

Hi - I am Mick O'Reilly.

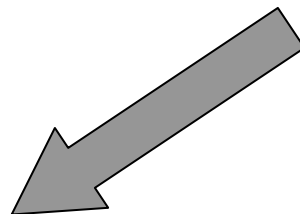
I am the Club's Safeguarding Officer.

I coach with the U10's at Canterbury RFC and have a Level 1 RFU coaching qualification.



2: What do I do?

I try to make sure that everyone who is under 18 years old is safe at the club. It doesn't matter if you are playing, watching, helping out or even if we have gone to an away match or on tour. I also check all the coaches to make sure they are OK to look after you. I also try and get everyone to behave properly.



3: What should you do?

If you are worried about something, you could start by talking to your mum or dad, coach or team manager, or me.

I will then ask other people what has happened and try to make things better.

I will have to write it down so I can remember and I may have to talk to other people who really need to know.



4: What then?

If the problem is another child then we will speak to their mum or dad; if it's someone who is in charge we will speak to the RFU at Twickenham to help; we can also speak to the police or social services if it's really bad.

Then we decide what needs to be done - we can tell them not to do it again or we can ask them to leave the club.
